**Title:** Director, Global Regulatory Affairs

ICI Global has offices in London, Hong Kong, and Washington, DC.

The London office currently has an opening for a Director, Global Regulatory Affairs who is responsible for identifying and analyzing regulatory policies and issues with a focus on Europe and key emerging trends in funds and fund regulation. Working under the direction of the Chief Counsel, and with guidance of other senior staff and the ICI Global Atlantic Policy council, the incumbent develops ICI Global's policy positions on European regulatory issues with global implications as well as provides commentary and policy analysis on EU initiatives and issues affecting funds, fund managers, and fund investors.

Essential functions of this role include:

- Identifies and monitors developing European industry and regulatory issues and trends with global reach and prepares analysis and recommendations for ICI Global and the Institute in respect of such development, with a focus on EU initiatives.
- Develops and maintains a wide network of senior contacts among EU and UK regulators and policymakers in national, transnational but also international organizations addressing fund management regulatory issues.
- Represents ICI Global in discussions and negotiations with national, transnational and global regulatory, governmental and industry bodies, in particular in the EU.
- Prepares comment letter and other analysis in response to EU regulatory, governmental and industry initiatives.
- Responds to requests for information and analysis from ICI Global and Institute staff and Members and collaborates with ICI Global and Institute staff on priority issues and developments.
- Works with various departments of ICI, including Operations and Research, as appropriate to further the policy work of ICI Global.
- Attends and participates in EU regulatory, policy and industry for a.

- Contributes to the management and deepening of engagement and relationship with the membership, including ICI Global Committees and Task Forces.
- Contributes to the daily operations of ICI Global office in London.
- Undertakes tasks and assignments as directed by the Chief Counsel and other ICI senior staff.

If you have the following credentials, we encourage you to apply:

- University degree in economics, law, or finance.
- Minimum 5 years of substantial professional experience in analyzing and addressing policy issues in fund management regulation, preferable in a financial, regulatory, or academic institution or fund industry body in EU or a Member State regulatory or policy institution.
- Deep knowledge of the EU regulation and operation of funds and fund management companies that operate on a global level.
- General understanding of wider financial and capital markets and institutions.
- Significant experience in analyzing complex policy issues concerning fund, fund manager, and fund regulation.
- Demonstrated ability to write clearly in English for both lay and technical audiences.
- Demonstrated ability to speak and present fluently, convincingly and credibly.
- Demonstrated fluency of an EU official language other than English (e.g., German, Italian, Spanish, Swedish, etc.).
- Demonstrated experience in engaging with a network of policymakers in EU or one or more EU Member States.
- Ability to work in close and collaborative manner with a broad range of staff and industry colleagues, and to promote an effective dialogue and forge consensus among ICI members.
- Must be willing to travel extensively (mostly in Europe and occasional to the United States).
